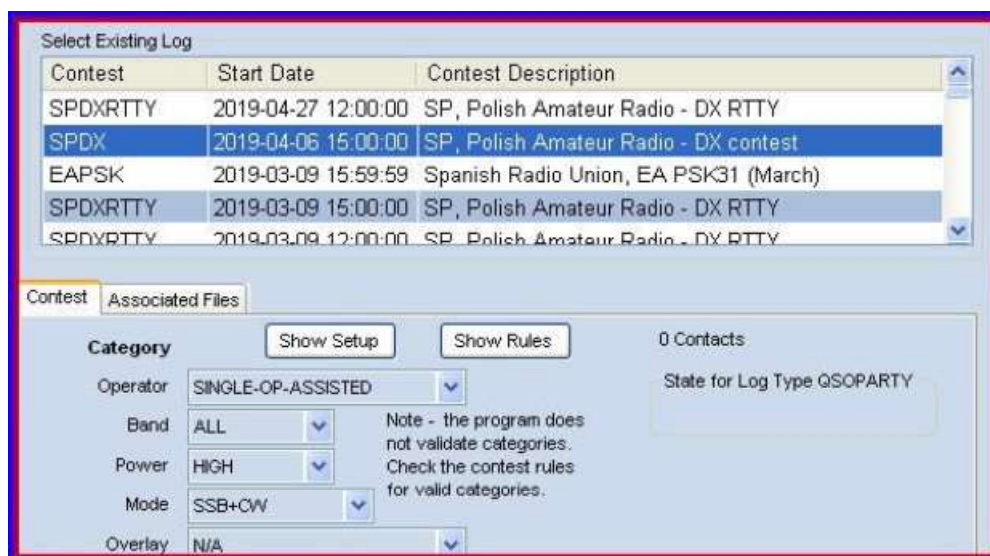


N1MM+ contest software

Super Check Partial (SCP) and Wojewodztwo (province) suggestions for the 2019 SPDX Contest

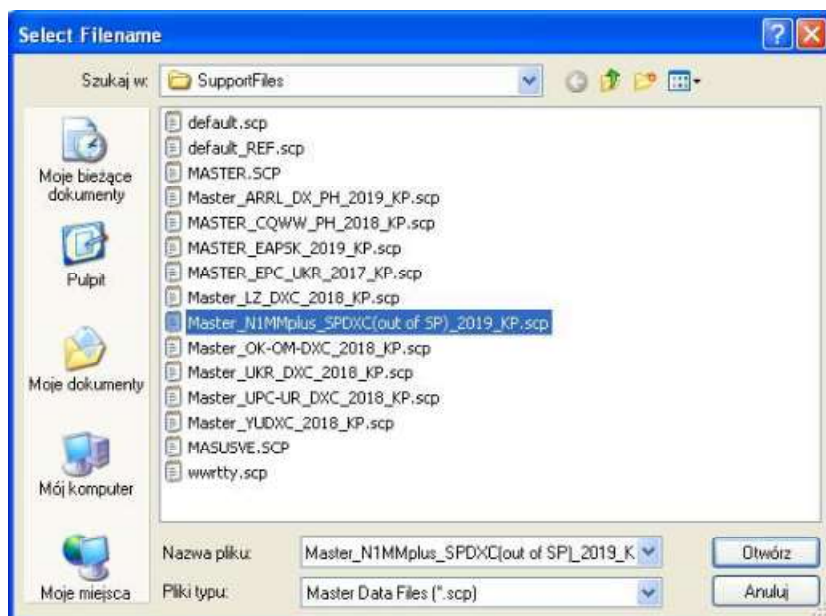
1. Unzip the downloaded file **N1MMplus_SPDXC_(out of SP)_2019_KP.zip** to the main N1MM+ folder.
2. Start **N1MM+** and configure the program for a new SPDX Contest.
3. Click on the the **Associated Files** tab.



4. For the **Master.scp** file, click on **Change** and find **Master_SPDXC_(out of SP)_2019_KP.scp** in the N1MM+ folder **SupportFiles**. Click on it once.
5. Below you can see the path to **Master_SPDXC_(out of SP)_2019_KP.scp**

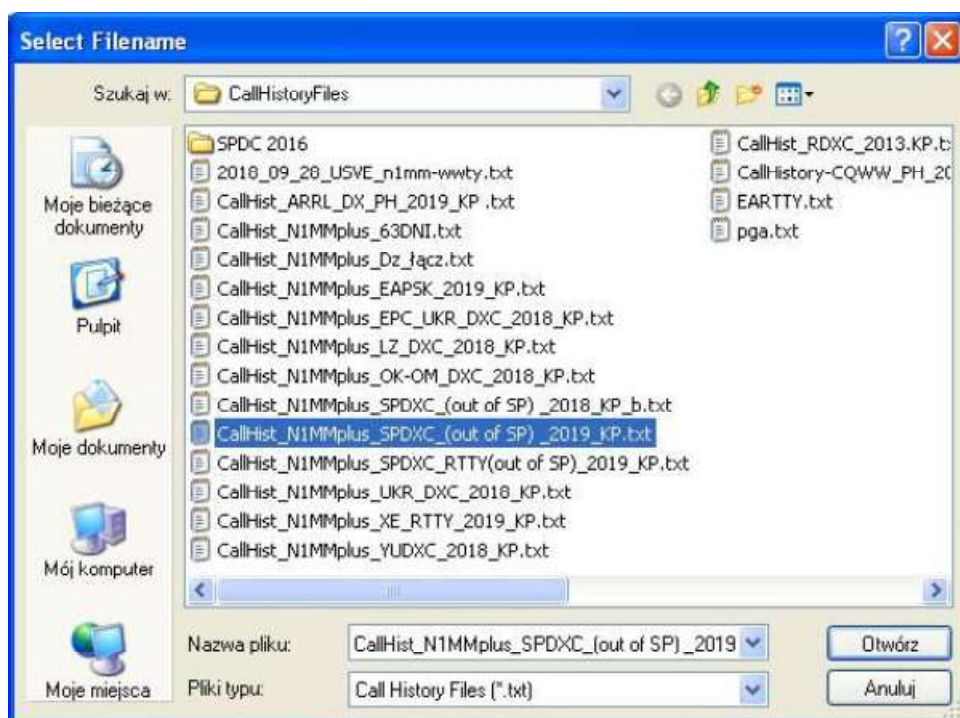
Note:

The file **Master_SPDXC_(out of SP)_2019_KP.scp** **MUST** be in the **N1MM+ folder SupportFiles** as illustrated below:

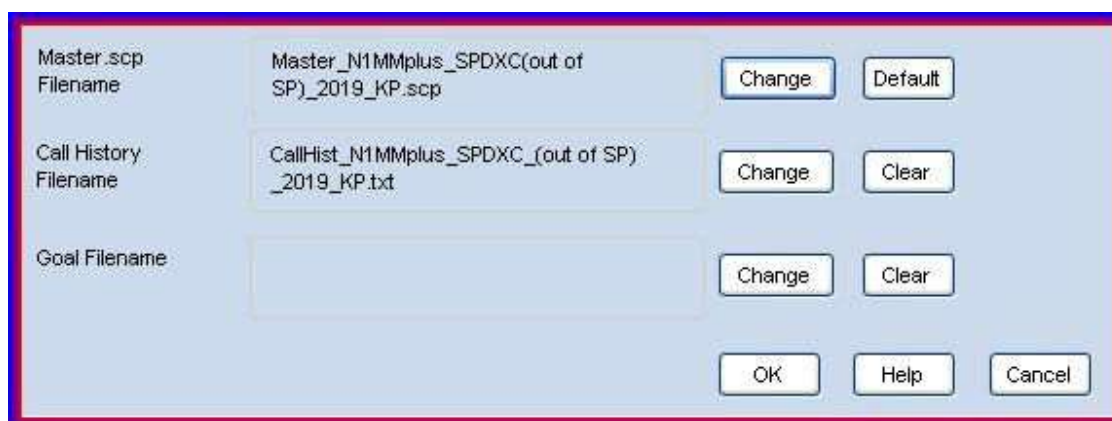


6. Next, go to **Call History File name** and click on **Change**, then find **CallHist_SPDXC_(out of SP) _2019.KP.txt** and click on it two times.

The file **CallHist_SPDXC_(out of SP) _2019.KP.txt** is in the **N1MM+ CallHistoryFiles** folder as illustrated below:



7. After configuring the path to the above **two** files, click on **OK** as shown below.

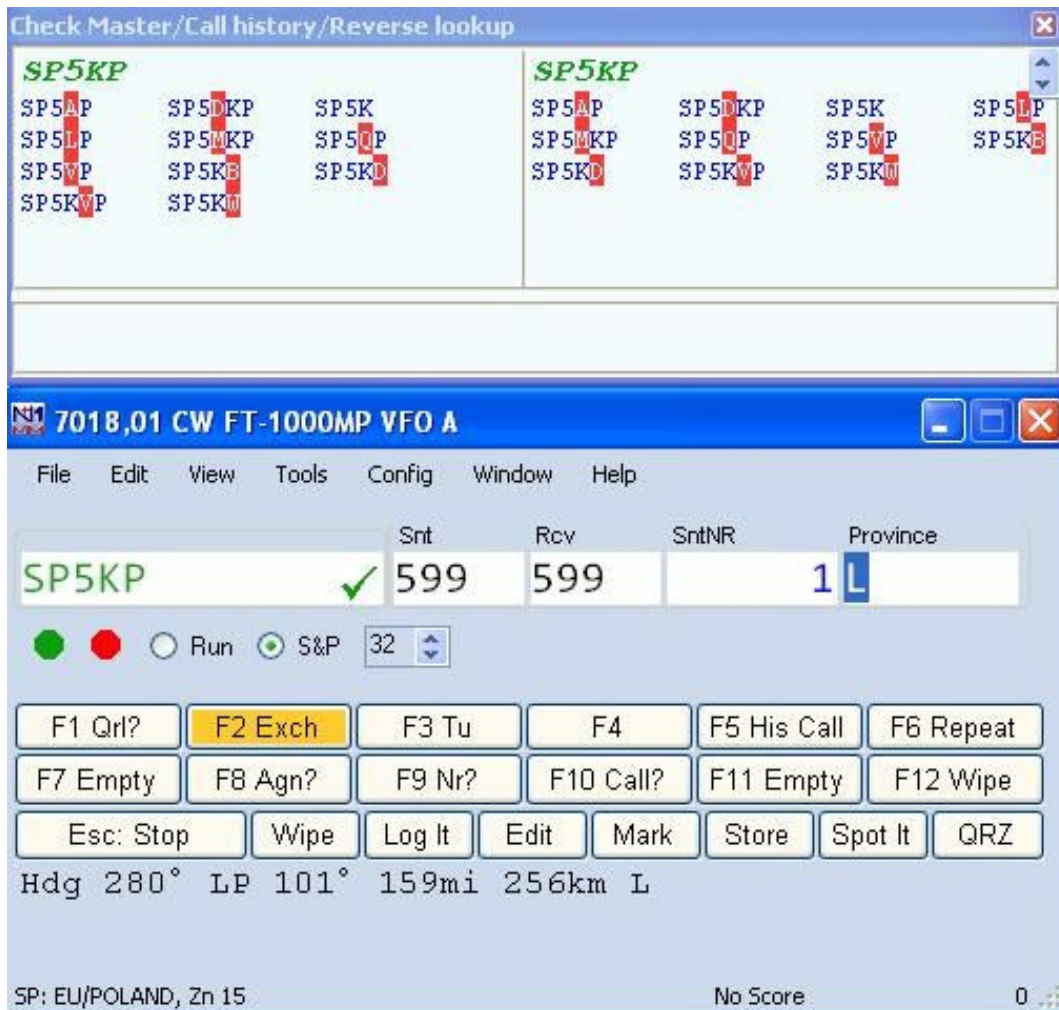


8. Click **OK** on the dialog window.

9. Remember to put a check mark beside Call History Look up in Config

10. To test this, type in a Polish call sign that is in the **CallHist_SPDXC_(out of SP) _2019.KP.txt** file (such as SP5KP), then press **SPACE**. The single-letter PROVINCE abbreviation will now appear in the **Exch** field.
